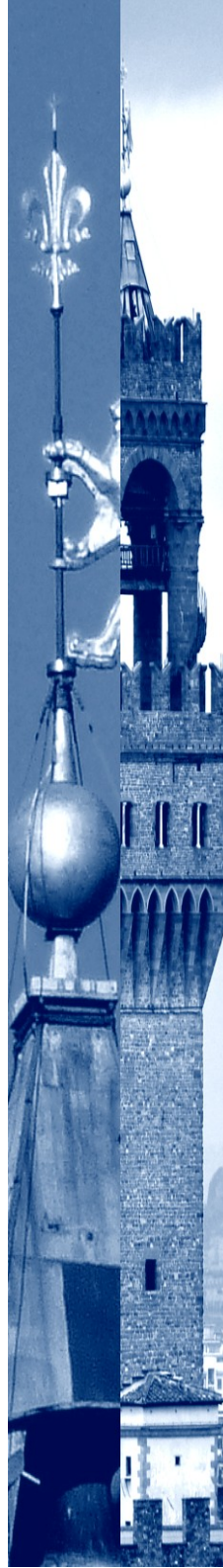
The Italian Workers Compensation Authority and the International Commission on Occupational Health, in collaboration with the Municipality of Florence, are pleased to organize, in the marvelous setting of Palazzo Vecchio, in Florence, the International Conference on *Active ageing. From research to action oriented policies.*

Ageing of the general population is a societal demographic issue at global level. This trend has a significant impact on the composition of the general population, with Europe, North America and wide regions of Asia and South America featuring more than 25% of people over 60 by 2060. Beyond the effects on social and health systems, ageing of the population is bound to have important consequences also on the world of work due to the need of ensuring adequate solutions for the development of a sustainable working life and an active ageing in good health, also accounting for the changes in work organization introduced by technological innovation.

At European level, many activities are already in place, such as those of the European Agency for Health and Safety at Work, which developed dedicated campaigns and is constantly engaged in the identification of good practices to promote active ageing. It also provides the European Commission with useful information and valuable tools for the implementation of specific policies to support the inclusion of older workers in the work market.

The Conference, organized as a side event of the ICOH Mid Term Meeting, gathers highly representative speakers, with the aim to address the problems related to active ageing of the working population. The programme will provide an analysis of current and future context and the presentation of models for the integration of older workers into the world of work through targeted health surveillance and health promotion activities, taking into account the changes in the world of work due to new work organization models answering to the introduction of fast-evolving technological innovation.

The programme will be completed by a high-level panel discussion on how to link current knowledge to an efficient designing and developing of increasingly effective sector policies.
